

Special Student Care Centres (SSCCs)

Service Matrix

Special Student Care Centres (SSCCs) provide before / after-school care services for students aged 7 to 18 years old with special needs, who attend Special Education (SPED) schools. **Integrated** SSCCs are mainstream student care centres catering to both mainstream students and students with Mild to Moderate special needs; **Dedicated** SSCCs are located in SPED schools and cater only to students with special needs. For more information on how to apply for a place in SSCCs, please contact the SSCC directly or speak to your child's school social worker / allied educator or hospital Medical Social Worker. *Important note. As SSCCs have limited vacancies, centres will generally advise on the availability of vacancies before proceeding to assess the child's suitability for enrolment in the centre.
